the trailing vehicle to	During the filming of a planned and rehearsed action sequence a change was made to the action sequence. The transition from the trailing vehicle to the leading vehicle was changed to be done in one sequence instead of two. When the change was made to the sequence there was no meeting held to review the changes with all involved.		
The change to the action sequence increased the risk of injury as the transition was now between two vehicles that were not connected. The sequence now relied upon driver coordination and performance to keep the vehicles close enough during the transition as the worker making the transition would end up rigged to the trailing vehicle but physically riding on the back of the leading vehicle.
